

GRADUATION OF ICT TRAINNES IN YFCs

INTRODUCTION

The National Youth Council is a government institution aimed to facilitate and encourage youth to participate in socio-economic development and transformation to a peaceful, prosperous and sustainable society.

The National Youth Council (NYC) in partnership with The Digital Opportunity Trust (DOT Rwanda) have trained 802 youth through Youth Friendly Centers (YFCs). The Training aimed at enhancing ICT and entrepreneurial skills of youth.

After this training, an event of awarding certificates is important and it will take place in all YFCs (where trainings were held), but officially the event will be held in two YFCs; such are Rulindo YFC and AGR Gikondo, where trainees (of two phases) will be given their certificates. Also other centers will offer the certificates at the same time.

- ✓ Recognize the effort made by the trainees and
- ✓ Encourage them to use what they have learned for productive activities

2. Summary of ICT training in each YFC first and second phase

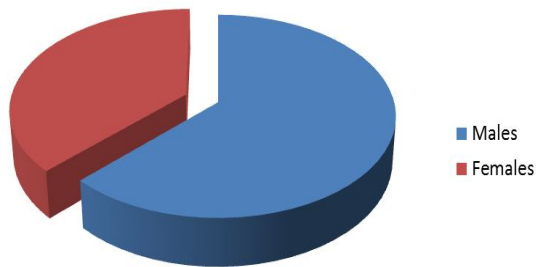
At all those YFCs the training of first phase started from March to May 2014 and second phase from June to July, 2014.
